

Engie raises US\$137 million in Chilean bond issuance

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Prieto has guided the Chilean subsidiary of French energy titan Engie in a bond issuance worth *unidades de fomento* 3 million (US\$137 million).

The deal closed on 4 June.

Engie will allocate the funds to debt repayments and renewable energy projects.

The issuance follows other recent financing activity by Engie Energía Chile. In October last year, Norton Rose Fulbright and Prieto helped the company [secure](#) a US\$400 million green loan from CAF, while Hunton Andrews Kurth LLP and Morales & Besa advised the lender. A month earlier, Prieto [guided](#) Engie Energía Chile in its first local green bond issuance, raising US\$120 million.
